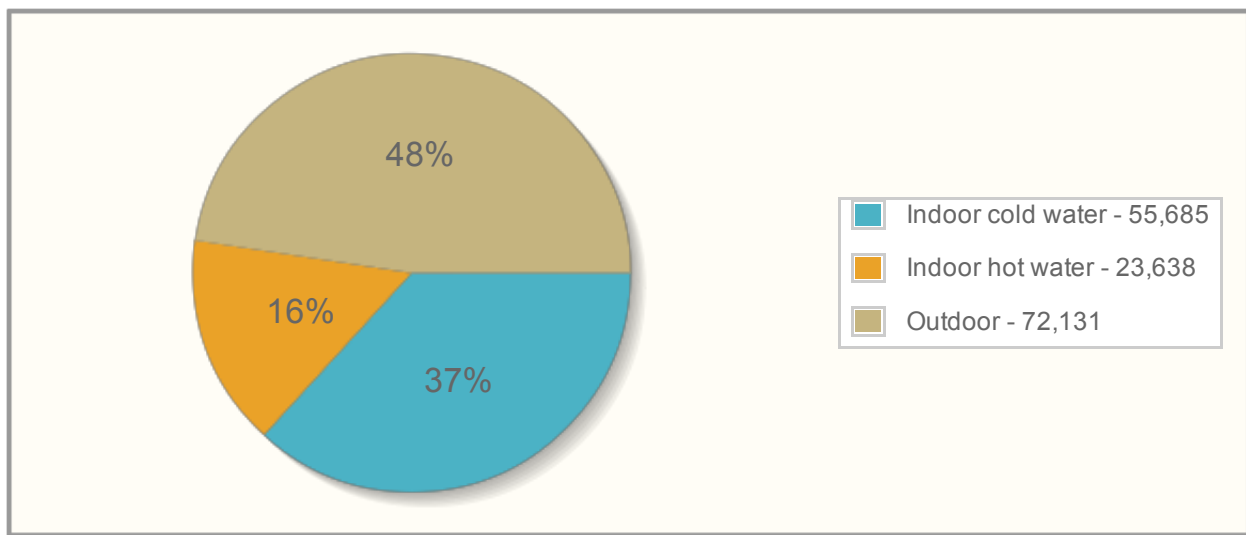

Water Usage, gal./yr



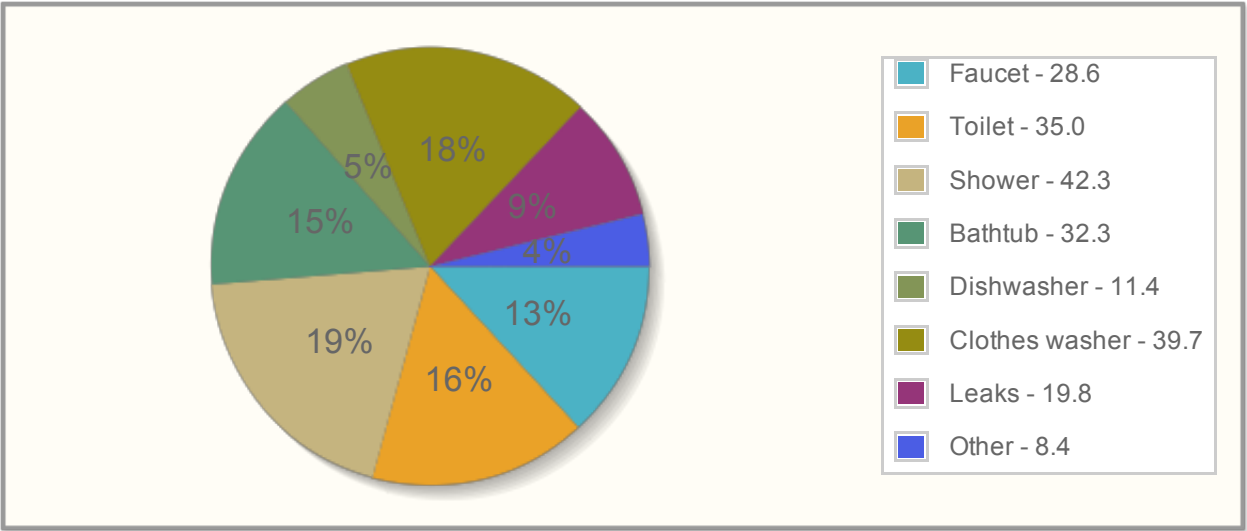

Where I Use Water

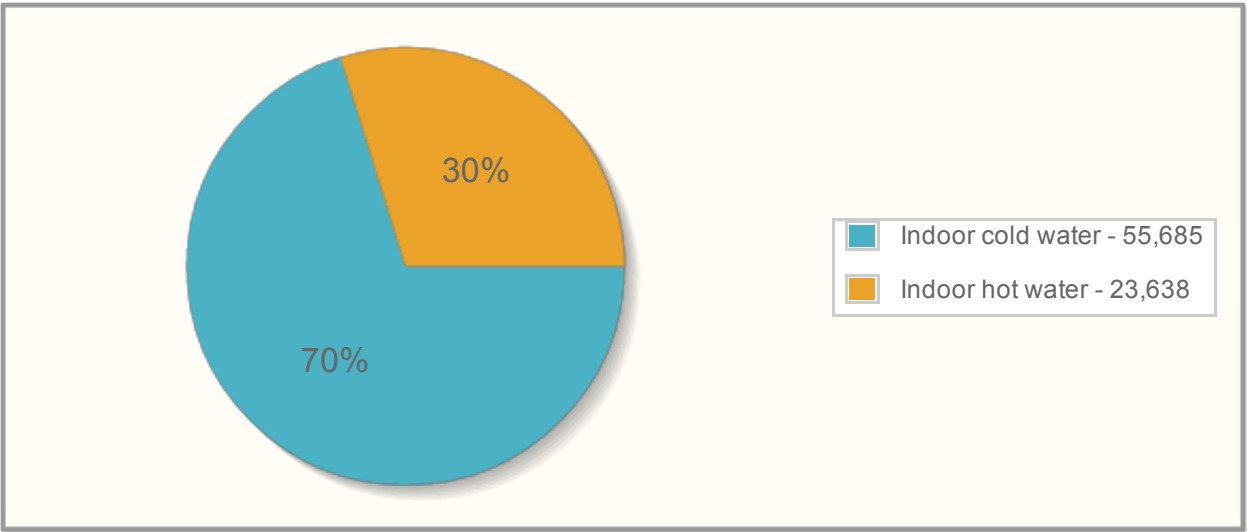
Water Usage, gal./day



My household uses an estimated 72,131 gal. per year outdoors. The average landscaped area of the same size in this climate would use about 31,165 gal. while a water-wise landscaped area of the same size would only use about 18,699 gal.
